**PLEASE LOOK AT THESE STATISTICS FROM EMAW:** For every 10 men in the church,

- 9 will have children that leave the church;
- 8 will not enjoy their work;
- 6 will only pay the monthly minimums on their credit card, continually in debt;
- 5 will have a major problem with pornography;
- 4 will get divorced affecting more than a million children;

Please pray for this ministry and its impact on the men of our nation. If you would like further information you can go to their website-just type in the name on your browser. It was striking to hear the leader say that if a man spends just 15 minutes a day in a quiet time with Christ, he is changed. Another piece of information was that until men are changed by Christ, our culture will not be. And when men are changed, domestic violence stops; marriages remain faithful and intact; families are restored and eventually a nation and culture can be renewed.

In recent months North Korea (map) has been in the news as our President has met with the Leader of North Korea, Kim Jong Un, for talks to denuclearize the Korean peninsula. Our TWR Korea director sees the meetings as positive and hopeful. He believes **RADIOS ARE STILL CRUCIAL TO N. KOREANS.**



**In a recent report he stated:** “Many Christians in Korea have been praying and yearning for years for the peace of their land. Because the government places strong restrictions on the flow of information in North Korea, radio is one of the few effective ways for people to hear about the gospel or other news from the outside world. Shortwave programs broadcast from TWR Guam play an important role in encouraging believers to persevere, the director said. He went on to say that and more programming has been added in response to a growing desire in the north for “external news.” However, even if talks with N. Korea result in a positive manner, information flow is likely to be restricted for some time. However, despite these difficulties, the desire for external news amongst the North Korean residents will grow, and that means that the role of the radio broadcasts will become even more crucial. TWR will give even more effort to preach the gospel to the N. Koreans.”

Radios are gotten into North Korea in various ways and with a plastic bag wrapped around them so they can be buried and protected without fear of being discovered. When the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 it was largely attributed to the fact that outside radio, much of it being Christian radio (a lot from TWR transmitters) had prepared the people to see it crumble.

S. Korean Christians pray daily, many for hours a day, for their persecuted brethren in the North. They have pleaded for God's mercy on their divided nation for years. Perhaps this is the time that these two leaders have come to their positions to finally see peace come to the peninsula, the Gospel freely preached and open worship restored in N. Korea. Please pray for God to open the doors of that land to Himself, again, and for the “Dear Leader,” himself, to be open to Christ and for God to bind Satan from deceiving those who are seeking to bring peace.
