Dear Partners, Friends and Relatives,



Family News: In June we were able to visit Dan's mother in Indiana and help his brothers and sister move her out of her apartment that she has been in since 2009. Mom had decided that it was time for her to move into healthcare which is the nursing home of her Greencroft Senior Living community. While Mom is still in generally good health and her mind is good, she has felt it was time she didn't need to live alone. The Haven is a very nice place where she has a large room with an attached bath and twenty-four-hour care. The staff check on her several times a day and night and she can go to the nearby dining room or have her meals brought to her room. (She probably isn't happy that in this picture her room isn't as tidy as it usually is, but it is the only one we have with her in it and we wanted you to see what a nice place she has.)



We are all very happy that she is in such a nice, secure and safe place where she is not only well taken care of, but other activities are there for her to enjoy. She is able to leave and visit when someone (usually her children) take her out to their home for a visit or meal. Dan calls her every day as she has her own telephone and Mark and Debbie live only a mile away and Joel and Barb live only about three miles away so are able to visit her often. Usually, every Sunday, the siblings have a Zoom call with her which she enjoys. Ruthann is near Indianapolis and Dan here in GA, so it is a good time to get together.

Now for some TWR news: We have been given some interesting and also disturbing news of some of the countries that TWR broadcasts into. In China, the government is increasing their general surveillance of its citizens with cameras being almost everywhere. And in February Covid-19 began to spread quickly in Phnom Penh city and several provinces. By the end of March, the capital city was in full lock down and remained until just recently. More than 400 people per day, at one time were being infected. The Cambodian government has been working very hard to prevent its spread. During this time our staff and other Christian organizations reached out to help those who could not go out to buy food.

We learned from a friend that many are buying food and leaving it in boxes at the edge of roped off places for the needy to pick up.

With so many being forced to stay inside, radio has been not only a source of information for the people, but our TWR programs have given messages of hope and God's love during this stressful time. We are thankful that our TWR Cambodian teams have been spared Covid, and the government has been doing a vigorous vaccination program. Our Team there asked that we pray for them and the listeners and government during this time. However, a TWR brother in another Asian country died of Covid in June.

In Eswatini (formerly Swaziland) there has been much unrest recently, which has caused some problems, especially in travel with the TWR missionaries there. They are generally safe but with mobs and rioting, being in the wrong place at the wrong time can cause problems. Thus far our people are safe, and the programs are going out faithfully, though some have had to stay over at the transmitter site at times as it wasn't safe to travel home at that particular time. Pray for Eswatini and staff.

God continues to take care of His TWR people. Some of our transmitters are in areas that are not particularly friendly, one being in the very seat of voodoo land. But God has kept safe and blessed TWR and us beyond measure. And as our supporters you have played a great part in getting the Gospel out to every part of the world, today, through TWR transmitters. They are strategically located to reach into areas that need to hear of Jesus and his love and salvation. And TWR360, TWR's internet arm that Dan is involved in, daily, reaches millions of others.

Thank you for your continued support and prayers. We are grateful and humbled that so very many of you continue to stand behind us in this vital ministry, though we may not have been able to visit you for years.
