This month, TWR was pleased to announce that it had reached a major milestone. Our platform, TWR360, activated their 100th language! It was only back in 2013 that TWR360 launched with five (5) languages. If you are unfamiliar with TWR360, or know only a little about it, here is your primer!

TWR360 is an online platform that breaks down barriers of language and accessibility so users around the world can download, stream and read abundant Christian media resources to grow in their daily walk with Christ. That means that anyone anywhere at any time can gain easy access via their computer or smartphone to a wide range of Christian digital resources in his or her own heart language. And there is a massive and growing catalog of programming which provides something for everyone.

When you visit the TWR360 site you are stepping into a user friendly platform where you can search by topic, ministry, church, or specific concern or question that you have on your heart. There are videos, audio lessons, topics for teens and women and men. And if you don't have time to sit and watch or listen, there is a download library of content that you can take with you. And there is a Prayer Wall where many have left their requests and have been prayed for by people they may never meet.

Let us continue to pray that the world will begin to open up! But in the meantime, pray for TWR360 and the team responsible for keeping it current and growing. And pray that many who find this great resource will find the One true source of life; Jesus Christ.
