TWR Affiliates with SE Asian Station to Expand Gospel Outreach

“So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God.” Romans 10:17

TWR is seizing a new opportunity to provide encouragement and hope to a **potential audience of 7 million** across the surrounding islands and nations of the Singapore Strait amid a prolonged time of uncertainty and emotional strain brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.



On July 1, **BE 107 FM** in Batam, Indonesia, became the latest addition to TWR’s network of affiliate stations with a broadcast range spanning Singapore, the southernmost part of peninsular Malaysia and parts of Indonesia. TWR provides the station with daily programming featuring a broad selection of Indonesian and English language short features, music, and programs aimed at uplifting listeners during challenging times.

With the new affiliation implemented, TWR has quickly moved to provide programming for prime listening blocks on the station’s broadcast schedule. That content will gradually expand as more cooperating media ministries decide to take advantage of this exciting and unprecedented opportunity and add their programs to the schedule. Already airing or slated to begin soon are Ron Hutchcraft’s ***A Word With You***, Tony Evans’ ***The Urban Alternative*** and David Jeremiah’s ***Turning Point***. They round out a four-hour morning block of English programs and contemporary Christian music hosted by Daren Tan. English is widely spoken in Singapore and many parts of the region. **Marvin auditions** and prepares many of these programs before they are aired. He makes sure they meet TWR guidelines and are culturally sensitive. TWR’s international director for SE Asia said, “When we say we are reaching people in the region, we are not reaching some homogeneous group of people. There are so many different ethnic groups that speak different languages living all over Singapore, Malaysia and the surrounding Indonesian islands.”

Please pray for TWR, BE 107 FM and all involved as the Lord reaches many through this station. Pray that He will open the hearts of millions to receive His salvation.

Hope in the midst of tragedy in Afghanistan: As Americans and the Afghan president fled the tragic takeover by the Taliban in Afghanistan, we saw pictures of thousands of people in desperation clinging onto planes and pleading for their lives. The majority of people have no place to hide, no place to go to escape the brutality and atrocities of the terrorist organizations. Over the last 20 years the war has taken over 164,000 lives of its 39 million people. The people are terrified and in despair. Pray that our programs broadcast from the PANI transmitter would daily bring hope to these people in deep despair.



Prayer requests for Afghanistan:

1. Pray that the Taliban leaders would listen to God's Word on PANI and that the Lord would reveal who he is and bring them into his kingdom for complete transformation.
2. Pray for many of our listeners who now follow Christ, putting their lives in danger.
3. Pray for many families with unmarried daughters 13 years old and above who are forced to be given to Taliban warriors in marriage.
4. Pray that God's Word in our **PANI broadcasts** will bring hope and eternal life to Afghans who are without hope.
5. Pray that TWR may be able to increase its block of programming to Afghanistan, as our content comprises the **only** Christian broadcasts aired to the country via medium wave.

Haiti continues to face the onslaught of one tragedy after another, with hurricanes, the assassination of their president, and earthquakes in Les Cayes this last month. Miraculously, our new partner station in 4VEH Les Cayes survived the earthquakes and continues to broadcast to these people who have faced so much devastation.



Prayer requests for Haiti:

1. Pray for everyone affected by this natural disaster and especially those in serious need.
2. Pray that relief efforts will be able to quickly respond and make a difference in the hard-hit areas.
3. Pray for the 4VEH teams in Les Cayes, at the main broadcast center in Cap-Haïtien and in the United States, where staff members are gathering information to share internationally and coordinating fundraising efforts.
4. Pray for protection from the coming storms, that it won't significantly hamper rescue efforts providing shelter, medical care, food and water.
5. Pray for God to provide needed funds of approximately \$20,000 to purchase a solar generator to keep 4VEH on the air.

TWR has been well positioned by the Lord to speak hope found only in Christ to the hopeless in both geographical areas!
