Dear Friends,

I am thankful to God for you and your desire to continue investing in TWR's US Spanish Ministry, and in me personally. I'd like to introduce myself and my family, then give you some highlights of the last nine months.

I grew up in Charlotte, North Carolina, in a family that went to a church where the Gospel was not preached. I thought I was a Christian until I was in college and someone (a Muslim, no less!) explained the Trinity to me. I realized then that I was not a Christian. For more than 20 years I waffled between Deism, Atheism, Agnosticism and Humanism. Then, one day my world was rocked when a bold Christian explained the full Gospel to me and challenged me to consider my state before a Holy and Just God. In his infinite wisdom, God saw fit to save me, and now I commit my life to serving Him and making Him known!

Even though I have never lived in a Spanish-speaking country, the Lord has allowed me to acquire considerable Spanish skills through a God-given gift of language, years of studying and teaching Spanish, and lots of interacting with the Spanish speakers here in the US. It is amazing to me that He was preparing me to use my language for His glory for so many years before I even knew Him.

My husband Sean and I have been married for 11 years, and I have two children, Miranda (24) and Joe (22) from a previous marriage. Since the kids have both moved out, Sean and I spend more of our time in public evangelism, which keeps us passionate about the saving power of the Gospel.

In June of 2012, I started with TWR as Jim Munger's assistant. I have learned so much from his leadership of our department, and pray that, by His power, I will continue to lead the department in a way that permits us to reach the lost and equip the believer to the fullest of our ability, and in accordance with His will.

Since Jim's retirement earlier this year, a lot has happened! Of course, we had the fire in December which had the Spanish Department (along with TWR Women of Hope and Ministry Services) in temporary quarters until just last week!

In January, I got to travel to Bonaire for the celebration of the Bonaire Power Up Project. In March, I joined the other RTM Partners in Brazil for our annual Latin American Partners' Conference.

Both trips were extremely educational for me and helped me to better grasp my role as Director of TWR's Spanish Ministry in the United States.
