

*Dear praying friends,*

*We have condensed the following note from our Canadian partners concerning our Cuba ministry:*

For several years, TWR Canada had been working with RTM (TWR) Cuba director Alberto Gonzalez on the development of new radio programs....One program that was especially needed was biblical counselling....TWR Canada reached out with *Hope for the Heart*, a Biblical counselling ministry we had worked with on projects in West Africa and Central Asia. Could they get involved somehow?

Trainers from *Hope for the Heart*...proposed holding a biblical counselling training session for Cuban ministry and church leaders. Their training focuses on dealing with life issues and finding healing and counsel from God through the Bible. The goal of their training is to train leaders who can then teach others. What a tremendous gift from God!

But God surprised us. He did not just bring about a biblical counselling radio program as we had hoped. He began a movement. Since those first few workshops, RTM Cuba was able to offer another biblical counselling workshop to more church leaders, led by some of those leaders who attended previous workshops. Through this, we see God creating a movement for Cubans, led by Cubans, as this valuable teaching is spread to more and more people.

We see God's hand throughout this whole process: training and educating church leaders through counselling workshops, bringing together the production team and increasing the signal so that almost every Cuban can listen to these programs. Please pray that many lives will be changed, encouraged and rooted in the Word of God through this initiative.

*So God is still actively working through TWR's ministry to the Americas! You have been praying for many years and He has been working!*

**“Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving; withal praying also for us ...” (Col. 4:2-3a KJV)**

>*From a prison in South Africa:* “It is indeed a great honour for me to find an opportunity to communicate with you at TWR. I always wanted to, yet I relied on my Christian brothers who were here next to me in the same section of the prison. I used their material and the information you shared with them to feed my soul with your spiritual teaching and encouragement.

“I am now left alone here, like on an island since my brothers are no longer in the same section; they have been moved to other sections and prisons. I used to listen to TWR and pray along with you and learn from God through your material and radio programs. I would like to request from you, if possible, to send me Christian material and help me with a radio, since it is near impossible for me to get one in this situation.” *Pray for all the prisoners in the various countries who have found Christ through the broadcasts!*

>*Pray for Christians in the Arabic-speaking world* who are harassed or even killed because they have left the state religion. Many have come to Christ because He told them to in a vision or dream! Arabic broadcasts have been going out to this region for many years now and observers who have been close to these people say that as a result there are many more “closet believers” than we would suspect. *Hope for the Heart*, mentioned on the previous page, is one of these programs.

>*Pray for safety, health, and God’s anointing on those producing the Women of Hope programs in Arabic, Farsi, Central Asia Russian, Kabyle, Kazakh, Kyrgyz, Kurdish-Sorani, Tajik, Turkish, Turkmen, and Uzbek. Thank the Lord for opening the doors to producing the Women of Hope program in all these languages!*

>*Again from the Women of Hope program:* Many women in the Middle East have been humiliated by their fathers, brothers, husbands, and sons because they have accepted Jesus. *Pray that they will hear that God loves them and that they are precious to Him.*

>*From Iraq:* We don’t hear much on today’s news about Iraq, but since the war, terrorists have burned the homes and churches of Christians there, forcing 55,000 to flee. 25,000 have returned and are struggling to rebuild. *Pray that the broadcasts will encourage them.*

>*Pray for those accessing TWR’s Arabic counseling page on Facebook.* Over 132,000 followers are asking questions about faith, the meaning of life, and Christianity!

>*From here in Phoenix:* We have discontinued for the summer the weekly Bible study I host at the church and are struggling to find a good time for all concerned when we start up again in the fall. *Please pray with us that the Lord will show us His will in the matter.*
