It's actually pretty neat for us to see him do his assignments—and especially to hear him learning Bible verses, saying his letters and numbers, and singing little songs from his schoolwork.


Please pray that the Lord will continue protecting him physically and spiritually—and that he will gain an understanding of the Gospel at an early age.

He has become our "go-to-guy" for grilling burgers—and he's learning lots of other things too.



LEGO Convention (before all the shutdown)




Zeke at the dentist and then getting a haircut

Jack Waltman is my newest nephew (he makes number 5) and we are very excited to welcome him to the family!


Due to the social isolating, we haven't got to meet him yet in person, but we hope to soon (Facetime is the next best thing).
