Greetings in the name of our Risen Lord and Savior,

I suspect that you have noticed that things simply do not last here on earth; they rust, they rot and otherwise deteriorate. Even a lifetime warranty eventually comes to the end of a lifetime. Christ’s resurrection provides an eternal inheritance to those who come to him by faith. Have you received Christ as your Savior?

Trans World Radio has two transmitter

projects moving forward. The ‘Silk Road’ transmitter is funded, and government permissions granted. Completion of the installation of this transmitter is scheduled spring of 2019.

The “Oasis” transmitter construction in West Africa has begun. The 200,000-watt AM transmitter is to focus on Nigeria and regions of adjacent countries. Please pray for the crews working on these transmitters; pray for the audience that will listen to these transmitters and pray the rest of the funding will come in for the West Africa transmitter.

TWR Asia is using TWR's Guam transmitters to reach the survivors of the December 2018 tsunami in Indonesia. The traumatized survivors will have opportunity to listen to the 70-episode program, *Therapy for the Soul*. These programs will also air on some local FM Indonesian stations. In addition to the Bible-based hope offered in the broadcasts, TWR Asia is supplying other aid and is giving SW radios to pastors.

The TWR video series *Share the Story* is a series of short videos of selected Bible stories from Creation to Christ that can even be viewed on a smart phone. Originally designed for a North

African people, the next step is translation into other languages. Church planters of another mission have asked for it to be put in the Jordanian language.

Listener reports: An elderly woman came to a Japanese church and told the pastor that she was not a Christian, but she believed the Lord sent her there. She had received a tract from a TWR ministry team member who was going door to door sharing the Gospel with those he came in contact with, passing out tracts and schedules for TWR's Japanese radio broadcasts. TWR airs six programs on 16 FM stations in Japan and on shortwave from Guam--a total of more than 200 hours of programming each month to an area that is home to almost eight million people. The Japanese people have been called the second largest unreached people group in the world.

Daniel has changed employers. He has more responsibility, more variety and is working with a great group of men. Recently, he became certified and operated a heavy-duty forklift with a telescoping boom lifting shingles to the roof of a 3-story building.

G.T. is always busy. After he completes his chores, when we are not doing school work, he likes to draw pictures of animals, look at the encyclopedias, spell words

from the encyclopedia with Scrabble tiles and do puzzles.



Joseph also has daily chores and likes to draw, watch videos and do puzzles. He delights in turning on/off lights and opening the garage door, so we are ready to leave...he enjoys going very much.

Sarah has not had the record-breaking snow falls of Wisconsin but had plenty of cold weather and snow. She continues to delight in working with children at the library.

Randy and Rose have already started the gardening season; potatoes and early season vegetables have been planted and the greenhouse requires daily attention. Randy and the maintenance team at TWR are busy working on numerous tasks related to updating/replacement after the fire.
