Ministry News:

Bonaire is planning to install solar panels to help power the facilities there, and as an added blessing the panels will provide shade to keep the scorching sun off vehicles parked under it.

The new West Africa transmitter is broadcasting the gospel into Nigeria, but the transmitter is not working at full power. Pray that the problem can be found, and the necessary parts located to make the repair.

In response to TWR's gospel message from the West Africa Transmitting Station (WATS), former Muslims have formed more than a dozen groups of believers ranging in size from 10 to as many as 700. TWR's regional director gives praise, "We are happy to see the evidence of lasting fruit in people who came to know the Lord through our programs and form cell groups and churches where they can have fellowship and deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ."

Listener Responses:

A Gujarati language listener in India: After struggling with fear, sin and many other difficulties, Divya (a pseudonym) began contemplating suicide. Then she

discovered a TWR radio program in her heart language.

"One day I decided to

listen to the program, and I was so encouraged and touched by the message. I prayed to God for blessings over my life, and he answered my prayers by giving me a son. I thank God for his blessings. This program has shifted my attitude and perspective on life, and I thank God for this. I've learned many new things through your teaching. Please pray for me and my family."

Garth Kennedy, director at WATS, shared a testimony of Rabiou our chief technician:

"Yesterday on my way back, someone from the toll gate stopped me. I know him from town, and he has laughed at me in the past for going to church. He is a Muslim. A while ago I gave him a radio so he can listen to TWR. When he stopped me, he said he was loving listening to TWR, particularly the *Thru the Bible* French. He also told me that he has been giving his radio to others at the toll gate, those that speak Hausa and Yoruba, so when their *TTB* programs come on they can listen as well. I will make a plan and give the others radios as well."

– A listener in Turkey - "I am a 22-year-old woman and was wondering whether women are worthless in other religions as well. In my family neither me nor my mother had any worth. Our family never asked us about anything – they just decided over us. The same thing continued after I got married. I always asked myself why God does not love women. What have we done? Even when we get abused as women, we get the blame and I couldn't understand that. I talked with a friend, and she said the evil one had deceived us and therefore we were thrown out of Eden. She said that there is a curse over women.

"Then I found your programs. I listened to them in secret, and it's difficult for me, but I always find a

way. Christ has done so many things for me. I accepted Him into my life, and I'm so happy because I know I'm worthy to him. He cares about me and he doesn't look at me as a woman but as His child. I never experienced a love like that before in my life. He gives me strength. Thank you for being there and for the work you are doing. It has changed my life."

Family Update:

2020 is a year to remember. So many changes have come that we would never have thought. Through it all God has kept us safe and we have much for which to be thankful.

As one listener from the Middle East so aptly puts it: "I will not allow worry and fear to overcome my thoughts and feelings, and whenever this happens, I run to the Lord. I am not perfect, but I have a perfect God. The future is vague, but God knows everything, and he is in control."




Since the garden slowed down, Rose has been refinishing some furniture.
