Dear Ones,

Last month, God suddenly took home Andrew, a friend and colleague at TWR UK, with whom we had worked together in Monaco at the beginning of our missionary journey. In less than a month after the diagnosis, he was in the presence of the Lord.

Recently, we read the response of a new Polish listener of TWR Poland. At one point, he could not cope with the tragic changes during the COVID-19 crisis. He wrote...

*My little restaurant went bust in the lockdown and I lost my only source of income. I became very depressed and made a suicide attempt that was almost successful. A friend found me lying unconscious on the floor of my apartment and I was rescued. He took me into his apartment so that I would not be alone. There I noticed that he often listened to a program called Thru the Bible. My heart was strongly moved by the words I overheard. I stayed with him for a month, but after returning to my home, I made sure to listen to that radio program every day. As a result, I have found the meaning of life and a new goal: to turn away from this evil world and find a community of believers who are thinking about their personal salvation in Jesus Christ, as I am today.*

For over two years, I have been participating in TWR's global project of setting up a broadcast monitoring system, which is based on the latest technology of receivers, the Software Defined Radio (SDR). Out of several options, we picked the KiwiSDR that was developed in New Zealand. It is web-accessible with open-source software and open hardware features. James, our project manager, works from his home in South Africa; Dave, our hardware specialist, from his home in Texas and I from California. We had to develop an extra software module for the KiwiSDR to enable it for scheduled remote monitoring. A major part of coding was done by two interns (Daniel and Christian), who joined our team for a limited time. The Lord has answered prayers and granted us good progress in the project. Several units already have been installed.

Abner, our son-in-law, a professor at The Master's University, also had an extra project on his shoulders last year. He has been part of a translation team producing the Legacy Standard Bible (LSB) that is based on the NASB (<https://lsbible.org/>). It was a very intense time for him, but Johanna and their four children provided a helpful support.

As always, we are deeply grateful for your partnership with us in our missionary service with Trans World Radio! Please, continue praying with us that people may turn to Jesus Christ in true repentance and saving faith all over the world, as TWR broadcasts God's wonderful invitation for life. Thank you.
