A trip to Zambia

Nathan recently spent a week in and around Livingston, Zambia. He was requested to shoot and produce a video for an offshoot ministry of TWR called RiverCross. RiverCross ministers to children who are living in abusive situations by providing a safe environment run by members of the community whom RiverCross has trained to recognize and care for victims of cruelty.

It was an eye-opening experience to realize the pain and trauma many children in Africa are faced with.

Those who are working on the ground in Zambia, with these children, have such a heart for their ministry and it was a blessing to be a brief part of it.



The video will tell a story of a young girl from a village who faces exploitation by her own Grandfather. It will detail facts of abuse seen in villages throughout Africa, the goals RiverCross has to meet the needs of these victims, and introduce Christ into their lives.

Tabitha House: Moms and Babes

Ruth Ministry has changed its name to Tabitha House: Moms and Babes. Tabitha House is a house on our church's property that is used for all their outreach ministries. Beginning in August, we now have our new structure for ministry, dividing up the weeks into age groups and opening once a week to offer a Bible study and skill development.

This month we did basic first aid and CPR. We had a nurse from our church, who has a certificate in teaching CPR and First Aid, come in and educate the ladies. There were lots of smiles and giggles as they tried practicing CPR on a dummy. Please continue to pray as we iron out details and kinks and get into a new rhythm of ministering every week.
