We sort of expected people to send prayer requests based on their individual circumstances. What we found though, was that they took advantage of the prayer time to pray for the salvation of the world!




**M**ost of our US Spanish Ministry team has been working from home for the past several weeks. This has posed certain challenges with workflows, processing of mail/donations, and team morale.
