Misconception about TWR in the US

I've come to realize that there is a misconception about TWR that I'd like to correct.

TWR is a global ministry, well known for high-powered radio transmitters that broadcast the hope of Christ to the world, including to areas of the world that are extremely hard to reach, and are essentially inaccessible to missionaries.

We recently had an official increase in the number of languages that we broadcast – the total is now 275!

Due to the emphasis on our international radio missions work, many people are under the impression that TWR does not do ministry in the US.

As the Director of TWR's US Spanish Ministry, I can tell you that TWR *does* do ministry in the US. We do it in Spanish!

Our audience is the more than 50 million Hispanics in the US that make us the 2nd largest Spanish-speaking country (1st is Mexico 😊).

Our desire is to reach the lost and equip the believer with solid, Bible-based teaching.

I'm including a brochure that we developed to help explain the ministry, and help people see that my team and I daily work to reach Hispanics living right here in the US.
