* We were standing on a bit of an incline so, in real life, Sean and Joe are not nearly as tall as they appear!




Visit with the Mungers


New Spanish Project

In my last update, I mentioned the Every Man a Warrior discipleship Bible study that “Helps Men Succeed in Life” by helping them win the battles they fight every day.

The ministry has a series of short (1 minute) radio features based on the Bible study curriculum. The “Warrior Minutes” air on stations here in the US and point listeners to a website where they can learn more about the ministry or purchase curriculum.

Working with our team in Uruguay, the scripts will be translated to Spanish then recorded in the studio there. Once produced, the program will be distributed to radio stations throughout the Spanish-speaking world.
