## Fire Update:

The Lord has been faithful to us these past three months and we have seen great improvements in the restoration and rebuilding process for our building in Cary, NC. We have received new carpet in the entire building, multiple coats of paint to cover the smoke smell, and nightly ozone treatments during the end of March to clean any residual smoke smell out of the air. At the beginning of April, we received the permits to begin rebuilding the area that had the major structural damage. The first task was to remove the bricks from around the floor of the damaged area so that they could put in new steel girders to support the new floor. As far as the less-damaged areas go, Amy and the rest of HR were able to move back into their area after the new cubicles were installed at the end of April, which is a huge praise; our financial department was also able to move back into their area. The estimated completion date for the entire project is now



sometime in July.

- Please pray that the repairs would continue to go smoothly and that, as the workers interact with our staff and see the ministry that goes on, they would want to hear the Gospel of Jesus and would come to saving faith.

## Amy's Update:

Amy has been traveling quite a bit in the past few months and has two more planned international trips during the months of May and June. In February she ran in the Disney Princess Challenge, which was a 10k on Saturday and a half-marathon on Sunday through Disney World. In March she took off for Palmer Lake, Colorado, where she participated in a partner's conference hosted at MTI (Mission Training International). In April, as we shared in our last newsletter, she flew to Germany to participate in a conference that was focused on assisting our overseas missionaries in maintaining and growing their support team as they serve. Thank you for all of those who were praying for this trip and for those who partnered financially with her.

I (Tyler) have been very busy in the past couple of months continuing to improve upon the code structure inside of our donor system so that we are effectively and responsibly handling the data of TWR's supporters. At the end of April, my supervisor, the Director of Donor Services and I attended a conference in Dallas, TX that was focused entirely on our donor system, which is called Studio Enterprise (SE). Our desire was to get a better understanding of all that SE has to offer, learn some of the new features that were coming out, and to make connections with other ministries that were using the tool. We are going to be upgrading SE to its newest version in May, which always brings some apprehension because of the potential change of processes, unknown ramifications, and training on all the new features.

We have been very involved with our church over the course of the past three years and have been praying for quite a while about starting a small group. There is a great need for new groups in our area as more people from our area are joining our church and want to have that Christian community/discipleship opportunity.
