Prayer needs

We have some very important prayer needs to share with you in this letter. Wayne is scheduled for double cataract surgery this spring. His first surgery is on Friday, April 24, while the second is three weeks later on May 15, which happens to be our 33rd wedding anniversary. Please pray for the operations to be successful and recovery times minimal. Of course, this has had a dramatic impact on his 2015 travel schedule. Please pray for wisdom in planning his major trips. It looks like he will be on the road more frequently throughout the summer and fall until the middle of November.

In donor services, Shelley is helping oversee the installation and training sessions for DonorDirect, software that will completely replace and improve TWR's current donor-management database. Shelley will be traveling to Dallas in early May to continue training in advance of the installation later this summer. It will be her responsibility to teach other staff in her department how to use the software.

Support increase

The final figures for our 2014 support revealed that we were at the 86 percent level in missionary support. That is an increase from the previous year of about 5 percent, for which we are very thankful! In 2015 our support need will rise by another 5 percent due to an increase in costs associated with missionary support. As I mentioned in this letter, a couple of churches have increased their support, as have some individuals. Please pray that the Lord will provide additional supporters for our missionary work.

In looking at all that's happening in our world today and especially the Middle East, surely the Lord's return is not far off. Let's be involved in the Master's business and redeem the time we have remaining before the trumpet's sound.
