Dear friends and family,

Greetings from North Carolina! Fall is our favorite time of year with warm temperatures, cool breezes and much less humidity! Speaking of the weather, we received a little rain from Hurricane Irma, which passed west of us in Georgia and Tennessee. The previous hurricane Harvey, spawned tornadoes in our area from its rainy weather that moved east through the Carolinas. A hailstorm caused over \$21,000 in damage to the siding on our house! Thankfully, 88 percent of the damage is covered by insurance!



We had wonderful visits with family, friends and supporters during our two weeks in New England in July. It was a blessing to have lunch with my brother Jim and sister Janet during a visit to our hometown of Baileyville, Maine. We shared TWR's ministry at a local church that partners with us in our ministry with TWR. We also provided a ministry update at another supporting church in Westfield in northern Maine.

We ate more seafood on this trip than any other visit to Maine in the past five years! Our culinary experience was "wicked good!" And of course, we watched the Red Sox play two games at Fenway Park. In the past four years, the Sox have won six of eight games we've watched them play. Maybe they should provide us with free tickets.

The rest of the summer was very busy too. Wayne connected with TWR churches in Wisconsin and Illinois in early August and later in the month visited churches in South and North Carolina! He also traveled to Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Maryland and attended a people group conference on Pakistan and Afghanistan in Virginia.



The highlight of our travels was participating in the Global Impact Celebration at Englewood Baptist Church in Rocky Mount, North Carolina just after Labor Day. This church is one of three churches in North Carolina that support us! We had multiple opportunities to connect with the members during the event. By the way, we also have four supporting churches in Florida and fourteen partner churches in Maine.

As many of you know, Shelley and I served with TWR on Guam for 12 years. The island has been in the news in recent months regarding potential threats of military action from North Korea. I remember the night we started broadcasting the gospel from Guam to this isolated, closed country. Keep Guam in Prayer as Crisis Eases

As North Korean threats of a missile attack appeared to cool recently, people on the Pacific island where TWR maintains a powerful shortwave station breathed a bit easier. Although North Korea's leader indicated that he might change his mind and strike Guam anyway, an official of that U.S. territory reportedly described the island's population as "almost ecstatic" about the decreased belligerence.

TWR's major transmitting station on Guam broadcasts the gospel daily to North Korea, where listeners face punishment for tuning into programs not approved by the government. For this reason, some Christians bury their radios in the ground when not listening to them.
